

## BUS HISTORY ASSOCIATION 2024 Convention DENVER, CO

The annual convention of the Bus History Association will be held in Denver, Colorado. The convention dates are <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>June 12<sup>th</sup> to Saturday</u>, <u>June 15<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2024</u>.


The Itinerary for the convention has not been finalized, but tentative details (subject to change) are shown below:

- Tuesday night, June 11 BHA members will arrive in Denver and printed itineraries will be handed out. Electronic versions (PDF) will be emailed out to BHA members a few days prior to the convention.
- Wednesday, June 12 Transit and intercity bus properties will be visited in Boulder, Greeley, Fort Collins, Loveland and Longmont. The BHA is hopeful of riding a restored Birney Streetcar on the Mountain Avenue Line (Fort Collins Municipal Railway Society).
- Thursday, June 13 We will travel west and visit transit and intercity properties in the Colorado Rockies. Included will be Breckenridge, Frisco, Copper Mountain, Vail and Avon. At Copper Mountain, we will be able to view (and hopefully ride) the only three door Orion VI production buses ever made.
- Friday, June 14 We will travel south and visit transit and intercity properties in Colorado Springs and Pueblo. The BHA annual meeting will be held in the evening at the host hotel.

**Saturday, June 15 –** We will stay local and visit transit and intercity properties in Denver and suburbs. A ride on the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Mall Shuttle will be included. There will be a late afternoon airport drop off scheduled.

BHA Tours will depart the host hotel at 8:00 AM on all days.

In **Denver**, our host hotel will be the Hampton Inn and Suites **Denver Aurora South** (2525) South Anaheim Street, Aurora, CO). The BHA has negotiated a room rate of \$149 per night (plus applicable state and local taxes) for rooms with either a King bed or two Queen beds. The hotel rate includes a free hot breakfast and the hotel has free onsite parking. The rate is valid from June 11 to Sunday, June 16. There are several restaurants within



reasonable walking distance of the hotel (Applebee's, Black Bear Diner, Texas Roadhouse, etc.).

The hotel is located a short walk from the Iliff Light Rail Station in Aurora (R Line). The R Line connects with the A Line to/from Denver International Airport at Peoria Station. Downtown Denver can be accessed by a ride on the H Line.

Please check the hotel registration sheet for more details. The cutoff date for the BHA block of rooms is **Tuesday, May 28, 2024**. The BHA would like to remind members to <u>register early</u> by filling out and mailing in the attached Annual Convention Registration Form. One charter coach (56 passenger) will be booked for the four days. The BHA will be cutting off registration at <u>45 people</u>. After that point, BHA members <u>will be put on a waiting list</u> and will be notified in the event of any cancellations.

The registration package is included with this cover page, which includes a waiver form. Your cooperation in signing the document is appreciated. The BHA will reserve the right to limit access to convention activities if the waiver is not signed. While most companies have relaxed COVID-19 protocols now, the BHA will abide by any policies put in place by the companies that we are visiting during the convention.

The Annual Convention Registration Form, Waiver and Hotel Reservation Information have been included with this letter. Please note that charter bus fees have increased over 50% since the Omaha/Iowa convention in 2022. The BHA Board has tried to keep registration prices as low as possible but at the same time does not want to expose the Association to the possibility of a large financial loss. An information package and detailed itinerary will be issued with your registration package upon arrival at the convention.

Denver and the Colorado Rockies is a very scenic area. If you have extra time, the BHA recommends visiting Aspen, Colorado which can be reached via Bustang (scheduled intercity bus service operated by the Colorado Department of Transportation) to Glenwood Springs. From Glenwood Springs, the VelociRFTA bus rapid transit service operated by the Roaring Fork Transportation Authority can be used to travel to Aspen. While the BHA will be going as far west as Avon on the Thursday of the convention, there was just not enough time to make it to Aspen. Steamboat Springs, also accessible via Bustang, is another scenic area to consider visiting.


The BHA looks forward to seeing you in June 2024 in Denver and the Colorado Rockies. We hope you take advantage of this opportunity to see old friends and new sights.





The hotel listed below is recommended and is where the charter bus will depart from at 8:00 AM each day. BHA members can book at alternate hotels but must make their own arrangements to be at the host hotel prior to the 8:00 AM departure.

#### <u>Hampton Inn and Suites Denver Aurora South - 2525 S. Anaheim St., Aurora, CO</u> Hotel Reservation Information

- The Hampton Inn and Suites Denver Aurora South (2525 South Anaheim Street, Aurora, CO) is the host hotel for the convention. The phone number is (720) 500-0010.
- The BHA has negotiated a room rate of \$149 per night (plus applicable State and local taxes) for rooms with either a King bed or two Queen beds.
- The hotel rate includes a free hot breakfast and the hotel has free onsite parking.
- The rate is valid from Tuesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup> inclusive.



- For days before/after the BHA convention, please contact the hotel directly to see if the special rate is available.
- Cancellations of reservations for rooms must be received 24 hours prior to arrival. Late cancellations and no shows will result in a charge for one night.
- There are several restaurants within reasonable walking distance of the hotel (Applebee's, Black Bear Diner, Texas Roadhouse, etc.).
- The hotel is located a short walk from the Iliff Light Rail Station in Aurora (R Line). The R Line connects with the A Line to/from Denver International Airport at Peoria Station. Downtown Denver can be accessed by a ride on the H Line. A transfer to the E line is needed to access Union Station when coming from the south.
- The website links for the room booking is below. The link defaults to 5 nights (Tuesday to Saturday). Use the "Edit Stay" button to change these dates if needed.
- The BHA block rooms will be released as of May 28, 2024. After this date, the BHA rate will not be available.
